Dear Parent/ Carer,

**Re: Year 7 Transition Information**

My name is Mr Mahey, Assistant Principal for Ethos & Standards at Beacon Hill Academy and I am delighted that your child will be joining us in September. I would like to introduce myself as the Transition Lead and provide some key information relating to your child's next steps as they move from Year 6 into Year 7, formally known as Transition.

This is an exciting time for your child as they progress into the secondary stage of their education. Below is an overview of how we try to make the transition process as smooth as possible for all of our new learners:

- We request information about your child from their primary school so that we have an understanding of their abilities and their needs. If we can, we also visit your child's primary school to meet them.
- We provide a parent and carer guide alongside various other information which enables parents and carers to further understand our academy. Information includes expectations and requirements for uniform, our 'Values Driven Expectations' rewards and behaviour policy alongside free school meals and 'Weduc', our parent and carer app.
- Subject to COVID-19 restrictions, we invite your child to attend a Transition Day at the academy. This usually takes place in late June to early July. Further details will be provided in due course.
- Also subject to COVID-19 restrictions, we invite all parents and carers to attend an evening at the academy. This evening enables parents and carers to meet our staff, complete necessary paperwork, order items of uniform and ask questions.
- We also provide access to a summer school to further help your child get to know their academy. This year, our summer school will run from Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> to Friday 6<sup>th</sup> August 2021 and is available for all of our new Year 7 learners. Further details will be provided in due course.

**Transition Days**

Should COVID-19 restrictions and our internal risk assessments allow, we will hold our Transition Days in the week commencing Monday 28<sup>th</sup> July 2021. If Transition Days are held, learners will be invited along with other learners from the same primary school. This will enable us to maintain socially distanced 'bubbles' as far as practically possible. As you will appreciate, the safety of our community is of the most importance and therefore, confirmation of details regarding Transition Days will be made available in due course.

**Uniform**

As per the Chief Executive welcome letter, Year 7 learners will be gifted a blazer and tie as a way of welcoming them into our Trust. Details of how to order and collect a blazer will be released in due course. We anticipate that ties will be distributed during our summer school from Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> to Friday 6<sup>th</sup> August 2021.

**Important:** please note we will confirm when parents/ carers will be able to obtain/ purchase blazers in due course. This will be available under the Parents & Carers, Uniform area of the website.

## Free School Meals

If your circumstances have changed due to COVID-19 and you are now in receipt of benefits such as Universal Credit, then you may be entitled to apply for Free School Meals for your child. Even if your circumstances have only changed for the short term, you still have the right to apply.

The Free School Meals entitlement can be applied for where the parent's income satisfies any one of the following conditions at the time of applying:

- Income Support.
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance.
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit.
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190).
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get).

If you believe your child should be eligible for Free School Meals based on these criteria, you can apply now. A paper copy of the application form can be requested from the Academy, however we encourage applications to be made online via the Academy website.



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## Weduc Parent/ Carer App

In June, we aim to send you registration details for our electronic communication system 'Weduc'. We ask that all parents and carers sign up for this service, as this enables us to communicate messages and information effectively and to gather key information from you in advance of your child starting with us in September.

If you do not have the ability to download the 'Weduc' app, or access this via a computer then please contact us to request paper copies of the forms. Paper copies of all documents are available upon request.
