Rationale

Beacon Hill Academy (The High Arcal School as was) received a total of £393,890 in Disadvantaged Allocation for 2017-8, including Looked After Children Disadvantaged.

The school's rationale for allocating this money has always been to address the current inequalities between children eligible for Free School Meals and their peers by ensuring that funding to tackle disadvantage is directed to students who need it the most.

We believe that the difference in the achievement of Disadvantaged Students and their peers must be tackled at source if they are to have a long term impact. This is why we dedicate a significant proportion of this budget to preventative work, working with families and Year 6 students to ensure more and more of our students and their parents are 'ready to learn' and have high levels of engagement.

In addition to this long term view however the school recognises that more short-term specific interventions are also required to ensure more Disadvantaged students make the same progress as their Non Disadvantaged peers and that, particularly in English and Maths their attainment allows them to enhance their chances of accessing the most appropriate Post 16 pathway.

At Beacon Hill Academy we are committed to developing every aspect of our students, taking a holistic view to education, developing confidence, self-esteem, leadership and cultural awareness.
