RE: Year 10 Mock Examinations

I am writing to inform you about the forthcoming year 10 mock examinations for your child that are taking place week commencing 28th June 2021 and week commencing 5th July 2021. The examination timetable attached is the schedule of exams taking place during the course of the two weeks.

Further information about times of the exams and individual learner timetables will be distributed in due course.

As I am sure you appreciate, the mock exams are an important part of Year 10, as these will give an early indication of how well your child is doing and allow your child to experience an exam environment in preparation for Year 11, in addition to allowing teachers to see how we can best support your child through the next academic year.

During this time, your child will gain knowledge and understanding of this important process in preparation for the public examinations in May 2022.

Revision

Teachers will be talking to classes with regards to the mock examinations, highlighting what needs to be revised and supporting them with different methods to do this. I would strongly encourage all learners to make maximum use of the time by talking to their teachers about areas of work or revision that they need help with or are still struggling to understand and ask for your support to encourage revision time at home.

Equipment

All learners should bring suitable equipment to each examination – spare pens (black), pencil, ruler, appropriate maths equipment and scientific calculator (if allowed) etc – and be in full school uniform. Bringing the correct equipment is the learner's responsibility.
