Re: Respecting each other and our world

I am writing to you to request your help and support. It has been brought to my attention that a small minority of our learners are not upholding our academy value **Respecting each other and our world**, whilst representing Beacon Hill Academy outside of school. This is in particular reference to learners' journey to and from the academy. I must emphasise that the vast majority of our learners represent our academy in an excellent way, and we continue to be proud of these individuals.

At Beacon Hill Academy, we expect learners to demonstrate kindness and respect at all times, in particular from the moment they set off to Beacon Hill to the moment they return. We will continue to praise and recognise those learners that demonstrate these behaviours, whilst challenging those who fall short of these expectations.

We would appreciate if you could discuss the following points with your child;

- Demonstrate kindness, respect and impeccable manners to each other. Outside of Beacon Hill this may be a thank you to a car that allows you to cross the road, or moving out the way for a member of the public.
- When walking to or from the academy, use the pavement, ensuring that you do not trespass people's property, whilst being safe from passing traffic.
- Ensure litter is placed in passing bins or kept on your possession until you get home.
- Keep noise to a minimum when passing through residential areas, especially in the morning.
- Use positive language, you are representing your family and Beacon Hill Academy at all times.

We thank you for your continued support in ensuring that all learners demonstrate respect, as this is the Beacon Hill Academy way!
