Dear Parents/Carers,

RE: Year 11 Update

I write to congratulate Year 11 on the high levels of effort and determination that they are putting into their studies – this is clearly visible on a daily basis. The way that much of the year group have conducted themselves over the past few weeks has been impeccable and they have worked tirelessly with staff to improve exam technique and adopt a multitude of revision strategies.

These signs are highly encouraging; however, I encourage our learners to continue to make use of our staff expertise and ensure that they have well mapped revision timetables which they stick to. As we collectively face the last push, I will hold an assembly on Monday morning for Year 11, to reiterate the importance of maintaining high standards of effort, focus and attitude until they have completed all of their examinations. I will also reaffirm that it remains equally important to take a break, get some fresh air and meet friends to socialise – a balanced approach is key to success.

I would also like to take this opportunity to make you aware that as of Monday 16th May our period 6 offer is changing. Sessions will run each night of the week, where subject specific tutoring will be on offer the night before a particular examination. For example, English Language Paper 1 is to be sat by all learners on 18th May, therefore, after school on the day before there will be an English Language Paper 1 revision session held instead of the 'regular' Period 6 slot. Whilst we understand that some learners may choose to spend this time revising purposefully at home, we advise, in the strongest terms, that your child attends these sessions to gain last minute tips and boosts in confidence with subject specialists. **Please see the attached schedule for further information.**

In addition to this provision, we will also be providing breakfast sessions in departments on the morning of particular exams, to provide learners with additional reassurance and further layers of confidence prior to the exam. Free breakfast will be available in the foyer for Year 11 learners from 8am.

Whilst we appreciate that this is a testing time for our learners and our parents/carers I would like to take this opportunity to reaffirm that we are very much here to support you and your child/ren in any way we can.
