Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Year 11 timetable – w/c 13th June 2022

Firstly, I would like to thank you for your continued support during the Year 11 GCSE examinations. I am pleased to report that learners have conducted themselves well during each of the sittings and the invigilators have praised them for their conduct.

It has been our school policy to ensure that during the first phase of exams, learners encounter continuity and continue to enjoy full time access to their best level of support, namely their subject specialist teachers.

However, from **Monday 13th June**, we acknowledge that some key examinations e.g., English and Maths have concluded and therefore, this creates a greater degree of flexibility for Beacon Hill regarding forthcoming timetabling. We therefore propose that Year 11s will only have to attend school until 13:15pm each day, **unless they have an afternoon exam or revision session.**

Please consult the attached timetable which outlines the plan for school sessions and examinations from the week beginning the 13th June 2022. Guided revision sessions are denoted in green and the examinations in yellow. Where your child does not have an examination or guided revision session they will attend their normal timetabled lessons for that period, where they will undertake study supervised by a class teacher. It is important that you check the attached timetable carefully, as it is unlikely to follow the pattern of your child's existing timetable. This schedule of contact will also continue for the week beginning Monday 20th June.

Attendance at ALL sessions until 13:15 hours and ALL relevant examinations timetabled for your child **continues to be compulsory**. Failure to attend may have implications regarding our invitation for your child to attend the Year 11 Prom.

I would like to reassure you that lunch will remain available for all learners who require it, including free school meals.
