Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Warm Weather Warning

As you may be aware, a period of warm weather is expected over the next few days. This weather is set to peak with particularly high temperatures on **Friday 17th June 2022**. In view of this, learners will not be expected to wear blazers on **Friday 17th June 2022**. Blazers will be expected to be worn from **Monday 20th June 2022**. It may also be advantageous for them to apply high factor sun cream before attending school and bring a small quantity to reapply during social times. We also recommend that learners bring a water bottle to school, which they will be able to replenish during the day.

In addition to this, the academy will:

- Have additional water stations at breaktimes and lunchtimes where learners will be encouraged to fill up their water bottles.
- Hand out free water bottles to learners that require them in the afternoon.
- Arrange two ice-cream vans to be onsite allowing learners to **purchase** an ice-cream or ice lolly.
- Some classrooms will be re-located in the afternoon to cooler classrooms where necessary.

As we are all aware, the British weather is notoriously difficult to predict both in the short and long term. Therefore, we will update you with any subsequent adjustments to uniform, should the warm weather peak again in the near future. Unless parents/carers and learners are notified otherwise, all learners will be expected to wear their blazer to the academy again on **Monday 20th June 2022**.

Please note that learners in Year 11 will be allowed to leave school at breaktime tomorrow (11.00), unless they do Hospitality and Catering in which case they should go to room A4.
