Re: Career and Skills Event– Dunstall Racecourse

As part of our Careers strategy, we are delighted to inform you we have secured 30 places at Dunstall Racecourse for their Career and Skills event on the 29th of June. **Places will be given on a first come first served basis.** Inspiring the Black Country is an interactive careers event aimed to inspire and inform young people. The event will reflect the local labour market and showcase businesses who are based and producing things in the area.

The event will:

- Inspire young people to make informed decisions about their future subject selection and how subjects relate to the workplace and 'real' roles within business
- Provide an insight into the world of work, enabling young people to engage with local employers through industry related tasks, hands on interactive activities that simulate real roles
- Engage young people in activities that will help them understand the skills and qualities needed for particular roles
- Enable employers to provide activities and show innovation that demystify certain sectors and roles

Learners will be taken by coach and Beacon Hill Academy Staff will remain with learners at all times during the session. Learners will be expected to meet staff in the reception area at 12:20. We will be leaving the event at 14:30. to arrive back at school at approximately 15:00. Learners must wear full school uniform for this visit.
