Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Warm Weather Warning

As you may be aware, a period of warm weather is expected over the next few days. In view of this, learners will not be expected to wear blazers **from Monday 10th July to Friday 15th July**.

In addition to the above, it may be advantageous for learners to apply high factor sun cream before attending the academy and bring a small quantity to reapply during social times. We also recommend that learners bring a water bottle with them, which they will be able to replenish during the day.

In preparation for such periods of warm weather, the academy has installed more water coolers in recent weeks, which will enable learners to replenish their water bottles with cool and fresh water during break and lunch times. Please encourage your child to do this during their social times. As well as the aforementioned measures, some classrooms will also be re-located in the afternoon to cooler classrooms when necessary. In addition to this, the hall will be available as a shady and cool area for learners to go to if they are overly hot during break and lunchtime.

Public Health advice is that young people should wear **light colour clothing**, therefore a short sleeve white shirt is ideal for school. Sports day will be modified due to the weather. The afternoon events and the plans for the whole school to join on the field will be postponed to a morning session, sometime the following week. Further communication will be sent out regarding this. Learners taking part in sports day on Tuesday can come in their PE kit. All other learners should come in their normal uniform with the adaptations mentioned above.

As we are all aware, the British weather is notoriously difficult to predict both in the short and long term, therefore, we will update you with any subsequent adjustments to uniform, should the warm weather peak again in the near future.
