Dear Parents / Carers,

I am pleased to inform you that tickets for The Beacon Hill Academy Prom will be purchasable on WEDUC from **Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> May 2023**. The cost of the tickets for this prom is £20 only. I have really tried to keep costs down due to the increases in the cost of living that we all face. This price includes an arrival drink and a buffet meal. It should be noted that if learners wish to purchase additional soft drinks, they will need extra money with them.

To purchase tickets, please log on to your Weduc account and the prom tickets will be in your account to purchase. If you cannot logon to your Weduc account for any reason, then please email us at [helpline@beaconhillacademy.org.uk](mailto:helpline@beaconhillacademy.org.uk) for support with this. All payments need to be received by **Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June** to enable us to confirm numbers with the venue.

Once prom tickets are purchased, they will be issued on the day learners leave school, we cannot confirm this date at present. However, in the unlikely event your child is not allowed to attend the prom due to their conduct and you have paid in full, you will receive a full refund via WEDUC and be informed as to why your child is not permitted to attend.

Security at the venue is very strict and they will only permit entry to learners who have paid for tickets, parents and carers will not be allowed to enter the venue at all, only learners in their cars will be allowed onto the site. Any parents wishing to see their child arrive must find alternative parking (train station car park, hotel car park) and must stand behind the barrier at the Grand Station. You will be directed by their security to this point.

The event will run from 19:00 until 23:00. It is essential that you arrange prompt and safe transport home directly from the venue for your child. This transport must be scheduled to collect them at the end of the evening at 11.00pm. Any parents collecting children will be allowed onto the site for collection.
