The majority of our learners displayed exceptional adherence to our dress code this morning, appearing both smart and professional. However, we have observed that a few female learners are wearing trousers that do not align with our school's uniform policy.

I would like to reaffirm our uniform expectations for all parents/carers. These guidelines were previously communicated to all learners during the end-of-year assemblies last term, and we provided a link to our Parents' Guide through Weduc and our website to ensure all learners and parents/carers had access to this information.

For any learners who may not currently comply with our uniform criteria, we want to offer a grace period to address this matter. We kindly request that this issue is resolved by Monday, September 11th, 2023. Your cooperation in ensuring that our learners adhere to our uniform standards is greatly appreciated.

Our school's guidelines for girls' trousers specify that **they should be tailored (not stretch) and full length**.
