You are assessed on two components:


Component I: The portfolio, worth 60% of your grade

### Fine Art



Similarities60% Coursework (portfolio)
40% Exam. 10 hour exam.
Folder work based on artists and ideas.
Creative and ideas based.

Differences-Must be able to draw/ sketch or paint. Normally done on paper or canvas.

### **Textiles**



Similarities-60% Coursework (portfolio) 40% Exam. 10 hour exam. Folder work based on artists and ideas. Creative and ideas based.

Differences-More design focused instead of drawing. Done out of fabric, hand and machine, so therefore, 3d or textured in nature.

#### 3D



Similarities60% Coursework (portfolio)
40% Exam. 10 hour exam.
Folder work based on artists and ideas.
Creative and ideas based.

Differences-

More design focussed, especially 3D. Lots of making samples and models. 3D outcome, wood, metal and plastic.

You will have 3 lessons a week.


- In the first few months, each activity is on a step by step basis to build knowledge and confidence.
