Re: Year 7 Transition Information 2024

My name is Mr Mahey, Assistant Principal at Beacon Hill Academy and I am delighted that your child will be joining us in September. I would like to introduce myself as the Transition Lead and provide some key information relating to your child's next steps as they move from Year 6 into Year 7, formally known as Transition.

This is an exciting time for your child as they progress into the secondary stage of their education. Below is an overview of how we try to make the transition process as smooth as possible for all of our new learners:

- We request information about your child from their primary school so that we have an understanding of their abilities and their needs. If we can, we also visit your child's primary school to meet them.
- We provide a parent and carer guide alongside various other information which enables parents and carers to further understand our academy. Information includes expectations and requirements for uniform, our 'Values Driven Expectations' rewards and behaviour policy, free school meals and 'Reach More Parents', our parent and carer app.
- We invite your child to attend a Transition Day at the academy.
- We invite all parents and carers to attend an evening at the academy. This evening enables parents and carers to meet our staff, complete necessary paperwork, order items of uniform and ask questions.

Uniform

I am delighted to confirm that by way of welcoming our Year 7 learners to our academy, Dudley Academies Trust gift learners with a free blazer and tie. Details of how to order and collect a blazer and tie for new Year 7 learners will be released in due course.

Please refer to the Parent/Carer Guide for information relating to the expectations and standards of uniform. This is available under the Parents & Carers area of our website.

Free School Meals



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If you are in receipt of benefits such as Universal Credit, then you may be entitled to apply for Free School Meals for your child. Even if your circumstances have only changed for the short term, you still have the right to apply.

The Free School Meals entitlement can be applied for where the parent's income satisfies any one of the following conditions at the time of applying:

- Income Support.
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance.
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit.
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190).
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get).

If you believe your child should be eligible for Free School Meals based on these criteria, you can apply now. We encourage applications to be made online via the academy website.

'Reach More Parents' Parent / Carer App

In the coming weeks, we aim to send you registration details for our electronic communication system 'Reach More Parents'. More information about 'Reach More Parents' and how to download it is available on our website at Parents & Carers > Parent Carer Apps. We ask that all parents and carers sign up for this service, as this enables us to communicate messages and information effectively and to gather key information from you in advance of your child starting with us in September.

If you do not have the ability to download the 'Reach More Parents' app, or access this via a computer then please contact us to request paper copies of the forms.

Please note the contact information we have for parents and carers was shared with us via the local authority. If you need to update your contact details, please contact the academy directly to do so.

Year 6 Transition Days and Transition Evening

Our Year 6 transition days will be on Tuesday 9th July 2024 and Wednesday 10th July 2024, where you child will spend two full days at Beacon Hill Academy taking part in a range of activities, getting to know the staff and making new friends.

Following this there will also be a Transition Evening for parents only on Wednesday 10th July 2024 between 6.30pm and 8.00pm. Full details of this will be shared with you and your child's current school shortly.

Summer School 29th and 30th July 2024

Learners will be invited to attend our summer school and make new friends and get to know each other a little further. The sessions will run from 9-1pm each day. Learners will be required to bring in a refillable bottle of water, snacks and a packed lunch, if they wish. There will also be an ice cream van at the end of each session where learners can purchase an ice cream on their way home, they can also wear their own clothes. More information will shortly be on our website where you will also be able to register your child's place.

Transition information will be regularly published to the Why Choose Us > Welcome to Year 7 area of our website and we encourage you to check back regularly for the latest updates.
