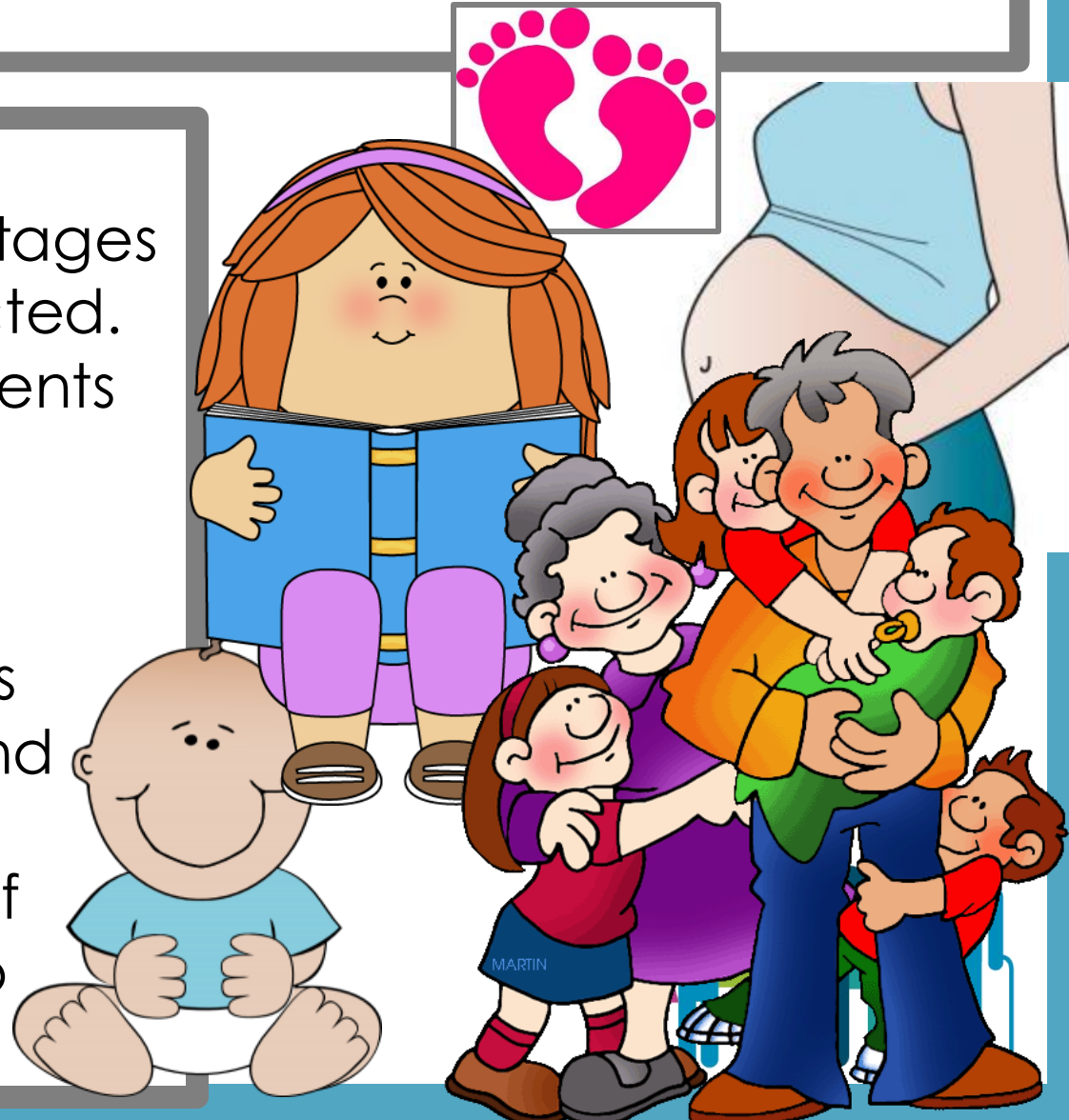

Component 1 – Human Lifespan

Topics covered:

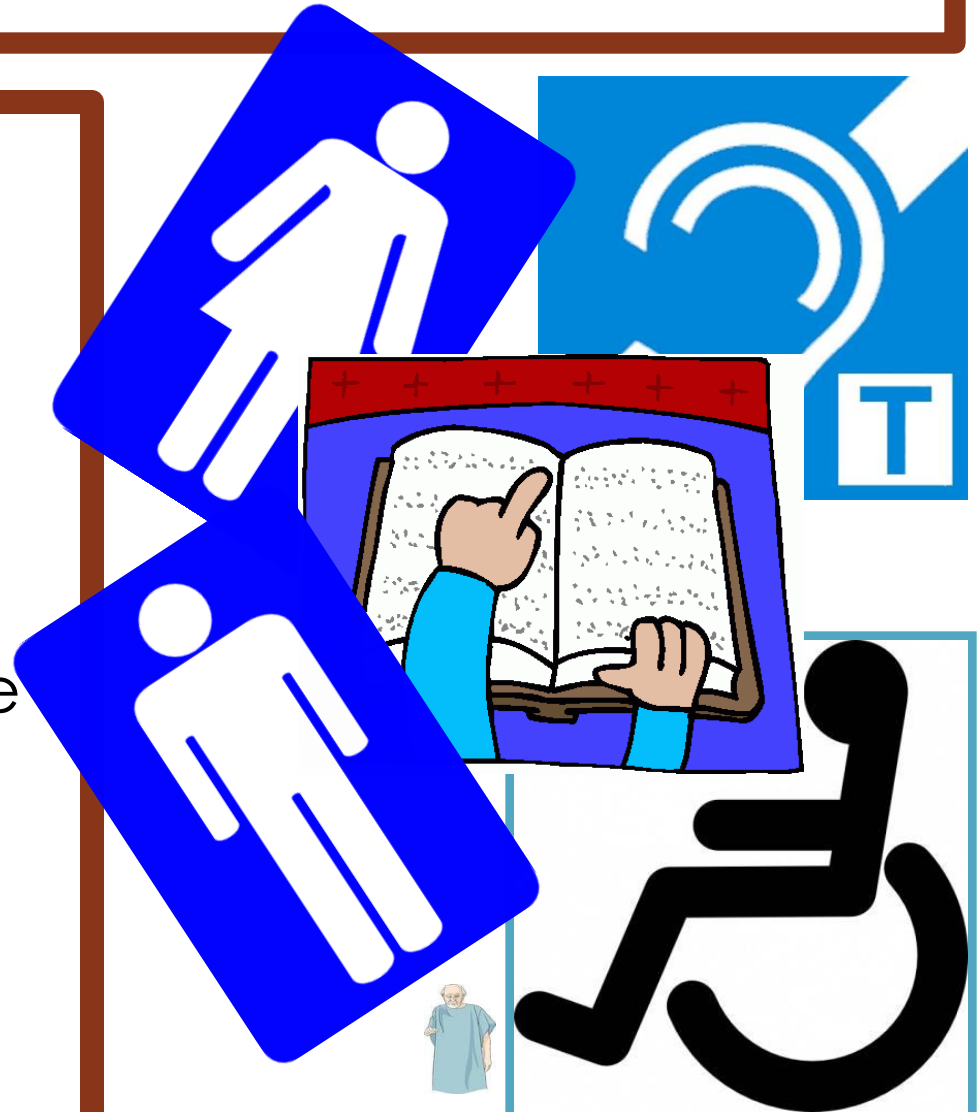
- The six different life stages
- How different expected, and unexpected events in our life affect our growth and development.
- How different factors affect our growth and development.
- The different types of development we go through.



Component 2 – Health and Social Care Services and Values

Topics covered:

- How a person should be supported throughout everyday life.
- How a person should be treated with care and compassion.
- How a person is kept safe in social care services.
- How well you can adapt the environment for an individual with specific needs.

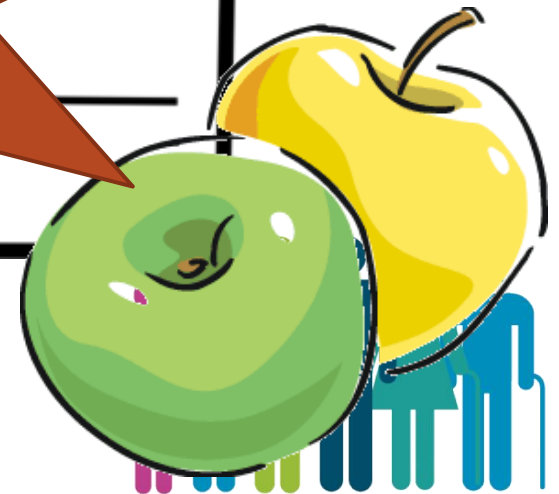


Component 3 – Health and Wellbeing

Topics covered:

- In this component you look at the factors that can have a positive or negative impact on a person's wellbeing.
- Designing an intervention for improving and well-being and long-term health.
- Additionally, you will face difficulties when trying to make these changes.

1. Reproduction & Roles & Responsibilities of Parenthood
2. Understanding Antenatal care & preparation for Birth

5. Child Safety

What do you study in Child Development?

Child Development is made up of three compulsory units:

RO57-The examination unit is 'content driven' - lots of topics to learn & remember. You will learn essential knowledge and understanding for Child Development.

RO58 and RO20 - will be written and practical tasks in the context of an assignment, selected from the exam board.

Hospitality and Catering



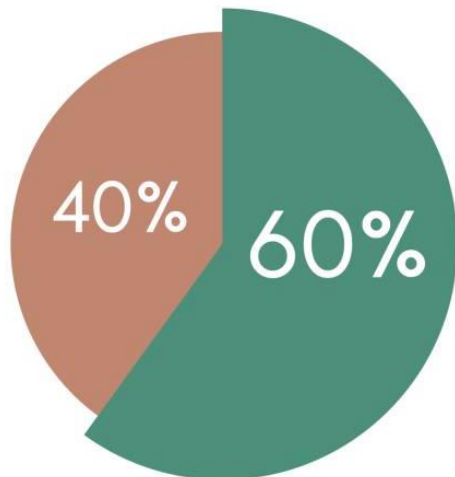
Why choose Hospitality and Catering?

What is studied on the course? How is it assessed?



Unit 1: The Hospitality and Catering Industry

Written exam— 1 hour and 30 minutes- 40% of the final grade.

Unit 2 : Hospitality and Catering in Action

Controlled assessment – internally assessed by your teacher. This includes a practical task to plan, cook and serve two dishes of your choice in year 11. – 60% of your final grade.
