As examination result slips are private documents, the school **will not issue results** to anyone else other than your child. This means that if your child is unable to come and pick their results up on Thursday 20th August and would like someone else to collect them, this is only possible if we have a signed note from them giving their permission. The person collecting the results on their behalf will also need photographic ID with them.

Unfortunately, we are unable to email or text results over to candidates. If your child would prefer to have their results posted, please submit this request through sending an email to abarnfield@beaconhillacademy.org.uk.

Arrival to school (Guidance for learners)

On the day, when arriving to school, a member of SLT will direct you to follow the signage through the car park area and to the entrance at the side of the **Hall**. All learners will be welcomed by Mr Mahey to complete a Post 16 survey. Once this is complete, learners will be greeted by Senior staff who will direct learners to the relevant results collection point to obtain their GCSE results.

Members of the SLT will be on hand to help and support our learners with any questions that they might have, along with any clerical re-checks, reviews of marking and reviews of moderation. Should any of these be requested, the exam team will be stationed in the Hall
