The site contains:

- Access to specialist mental health experts, in partnership with the charity TRN (Trauma Response Network)

- Recorded Lessons on-demand
- Online courses with credits/qualifications

Your Year 10 child will receive an email from Eduu.School to their school account (in the next few days) giving them access and introducing them to a wealth of opportunities available. Included in Eduu.School is the potential to win prizes (Apple ear pods among others) based on the amount of time that learners engage with the online resources, quizzes and independent work.
